Context:

The East Harptree Environment Group have been developing the churchyard to promote biodiversity. The aim of our management plan is to create:

1) a wildlife haven and a peaceful outdoor space where both villagers and visitors, especially walkers passing through, will want to linger and enjoy the sights, scents and sounds of the flora and fauna living there and

2) an outdoor classroom for children at the primary school, and others, to learn about, and come to appreciate, the wonderful wildlife in East Harptree.

We aim to include plants that provide nectar and pollen for insects from early spring to late autumn.

Opening:

The church yard is open at any time but the Love Your church Yard picnic (bring your own) is between 2-4pm on 15th June.

People may also like to visit the church where a range of restoration activities have recently taken place as part of Project Newton. Amongst other things stained glass windows have been restored and wall paintings have been revealed, that had been whitewashed over for many years.
